Twice a month we explore everything from the cosmic to the microscopic. All are welcome, but open and inquiring minds are recommended.

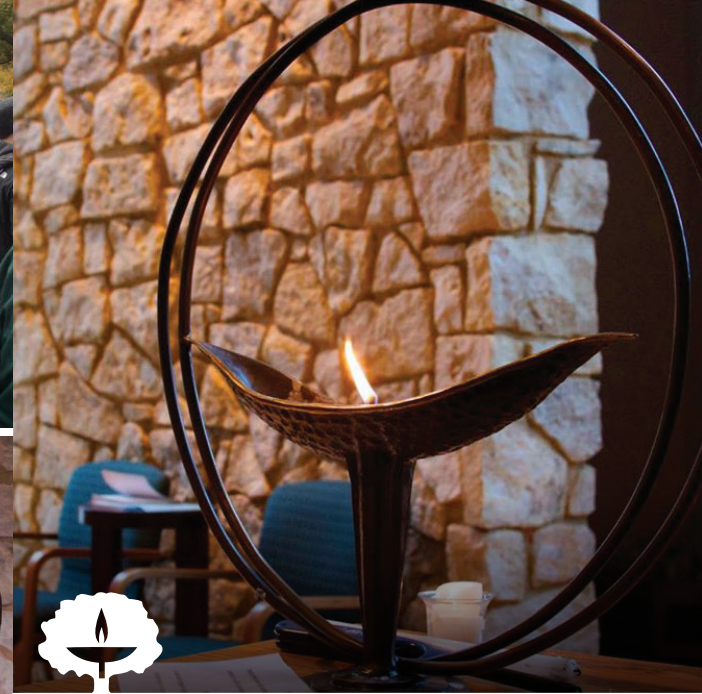


Community Involvement & Social Action
